

Mobile Library Services: possible stop frequencies and locations

The table below sets out an initial assessment of the communities that could be served by new mobile stops, if the library in the first column is not maintained through a Community Library Partnership. Where library buildings are maintained through Community Library Partnerships, we will not provide additional mobile library stops. Where we are unable to establish Community Library Partnerships, we will engage with local communities and staff to develop a timetable which provides the most effective and efficient mobile library service. This engagement exercise could result in changes to the possible stop frequencies and locations shown in the table below, which should be read as a guide only. Further information will be published as implementation plans develop.
